We will be presenting both digital and physical posters. You are welcome to apply to present both digital and physical versions of the same poster. All text on posters should be in English. We aim to make this conference as accessible as possible; please ensure that all text is easy to read.

**Printed posters** should be standard poster size, A0 (841mm x 1189mm) and portrait orientation. Presenters are welcome to bring leaflets or other printed material to hand out to attendees. If an organisation wishes to submit more than one poster, please send these together and indicate which poster is your priority for in-person presentation.

**Digital posters** should be submitted in PDF format and should be in portrait orientation. Please send your poster and the information listed below to <a href="mailto:international@bl.uk">international@bl.uk</a> by **Monday 29 July 2024**. We have capacity to present a limited number of posters; the British Library team will be in touch with the status of your application by 30 August 2024.

Please include the following information with your poster:

- A. Full name
- B. Email address
- C. Institution
- D. Institution country
- E. Poster title
- F. Poster description (two sentences maximum)
- G. Whether your poster will be presented digitally or in-person
- H. Confirmation that you give permission for this information and your poster to be displayed on the conference web page
- I. Whether you require the British Library to print your poster for you. Please note that you will be required to attend the conference in person if you wish to present a printed poster

We will be welcoming attendees both in-person and online over two days. Tickets for in-person attendees are £70 (with a percentage reserved for students at £35), and tickets for those joining online are free. For in-person attendees, lunch and refreshments will be provided over both days at no extra cost. Unfortunately, we are not able to offer an in-person discount to attendees who are presenting a poster.
