

METHODOLOGY REPORT

The Montevideo newspapers LE PATRIOTE FRANÇAIS, COMERCIO DEL PLATA, THE RIVER PLATE TIMES, and THE MONTEVIDEO TIMES were digitized in accordance with the guidelines outlined in project EAP 1466.

While undertaking this endeavor, we encountered certain challenges such as incomplete collections or damaged copies. Despite our efforts to rectify these issues, restoration was not always feasible. However, we employed various photographic techniques to enhance legibility, a standard practice in our methodology.

Specifically addressing THE MONTEVIDEO TIMES collection, after consulting with the British Library on November 30, 2023, it was determined to exclusively digitize copies available at the library of the Anglo Uruguayan Institute in Montevideo. This decision, which was made in collaboration with the institute, is applicable from the volume containing newspapers published in the first half of 1914 through the entirety of 1930.

The digitized publications encompass content in Spanish, French, or English, with occasional Spanish texts appearing in both the French and English newspapers.
